Vision, Mission and Study Program Specification Audit Report

1. Objective

Internal Quality Audit of study program specification standards and vision and mission is carried out to measure the success of developing the vision and mission, objectives, study program profile, self-evaluation, graduate achievements and graduate competency standards as well as improving the professionalism of the academic community in the study program.

2. Management Review Meeting Results (Previous Year)

2.1 Follow-up findings

S2 Accounting

1. There is no association/KKNI study material according to level
2. RPS through the benchmarking process at international institutions has not been carried out
3. There is no evaluation of the suitability between the research roadmap and the research conducted periodically.
4. There is no evaluation of the suitability between the community service roadmap and the community service that is carried out periodically.
5. The curriculum development plan has not been made based on the results of the analysis of user needs and the analysis of the success of the previous curriculum, while what has been done is based on the analysis of graduate competencies and SWOT analysis.

S2 Management

6. Graduate achievements are in accordance with the specifications of competent study programs, have been carried out but there are no reports yet
7. The success of graduates is monitored every year, it has been done (2019, 2020, 2021) but for 2022 it needs to be completed

Master of Economics Education

8. There is no document that proves that the curriculum has been restructured periodically and continuously based on input from stakeholders, alumni and the community. The last time the restructuring was carried out was not recorded.
9. There is no OBE-based KKNI curriculum document containing the objectives of the study program. Therefore, a re-evaluation is needed.

S1 Economic Education

10. CPMK indicators were not assessed according to 3 domains (cognitive, psychomotor, and affective), no CPL assessment was carried out for the 2020, 2021, 2022 intakes.
11. There is no information on improvements to CPL or CPMK after the evaluation, no assessment of CPL for the 2020, 2021, 2022 intakes was carried out for each year to measure achievements in 1 cycle and every 4 years to measure the success of all CPLs (assessment report for the current intake year)
12. The Semester Learning Plan (RPS) for each course has not gone through a benchmarking process at international institutions.

13. Elective courses do not show any contribution to the development of graduate profiles. There are 9 (pure) economics courses as elective courses, but the study program has not accommodated elective courses in the field of education.
14. There is no evaluation of the suitability between the research roadmap and the research conducted periodically.
15. There is no evaluation of the suitability between the community service roadmap and the community service that is carried out periodically.
16. The mapping of the professionalism of lecturers and education staff was developed not based on the results of the study program SWOT analysis. The professionalism of the study program lecturers has been in accordance with the specifications set, but information regarding the SWOT analysis as the basis for the mapping has not been shown.
17. The curriculum development plan is made based on the results of the analysis of user needs, graduate competencies, but does not use SWOT analysis and analysis of the success of the previous curriculum.
18. The success of graduate achievements is not monitored annually according to the current year's intake. No CPL assessment was carried out for the 2020, 2021, 2022 intakes. However, the study program has a work program for 2023 to conduct a CPL assessment for the 2020, 2021, 2022 intakes.





Figure 1 Spider web of S2 Economics Education audit






Figure 4 Spider web audit S1 Office Education




Figure 5 Spider web of S1 Business Education audit




Figure 6 S1 Management audit spider web




Figure 7 Master of Management audit spider web




Figure 8 S3 Management audit spider web




Figure 9 S1 Accounting audit spider web




Figure 10 S2 Accounting audit spider web




Figure 11 Spider web audit of S1 Islamic Economics




Figure 12 Spider web of audit of S2 Islamic Economy and Halal Industry




Figure 13 Undergraduate Economics audit spider web




Figure 14 S1 Digital Business audit spider web




Figure 15 Spider web of S1 Economics Education audit
