## **PREFACE**

We offer praise and gratitude to God Almighty for the completion of this Guidebook for New Student Admission Year 2023. This guidebook is published as a reference for the implementation of new student admissions at Universitas Negeri Surabaya(Unesa), especially on the independent path.

As one of the universities that develops society, especially in the field of education, Unesa continues to be committed to maintaining the quality of human resources, including students. One of the initial gates to maintaining the quality of human resources is through the admission of new students. Therefore, Unesa issued new student admission guidelines that guide the implementation of new student admissions. In its development through independent learning, new student admissions are no longer like in the past where students could only choose majors that are in line with majors in high school, but now participants can choose cross majors that are different from majors when in high school.

Guidelines are needed to facilitate the implementation of new student admissions, especially on independent pathways. The preparation of the independent pathway new student admission guidebook is based on government regulations, especially the Minister of Education, Culture, Research and Technology regulation number 48 of 2022. Through this guidebook, the new student admission process can be carried out well, and in the future, it will be able to develop further.

Considering the rapid development of educational issues in Indonesia and the impact on new student admission policies at Universitas Negeri Surabaya, this guideline may still undergo revision in the next edition. Input from parties involved in the implementation of new student admissions at Universitas negeri Surabaya will be eagerly awaited in order to refine these guidelines, as well as further improve the quality of education at Universitas Negeri Surabaya.

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# CHAPTER I

## INTRODUCTION

### A. BACKGROUND

Public interest in developing the quality of human resources makes universities must be ready to continue to improve the quality of education. Modern society is no longer blind to the quality of education, especially at the higher education level. People will choose which universities have good quality, and which universities have poor quality. The quality of higher education is seen from how students contribute to society. The process of improving the quality of students begins with the admission of new students.

Changes to the selection for new student admissions (SPMB) through the Regulation of the Minister of Education, Culture, Research and Technology of the Republic of Indonesia Number 48 of 2022 concerning Admission of New Students for Diploma Programs and Undergraduate Programs at State Universities has an impact on changes in the acceptance of new students, including those held independently by universities. Apart from that, with the development of the concept of independent learning which was conceptualized by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology of the Republic of Indonesia, the process of accepting new students, especially in selecting study programs, is no longer a limitation, where students can choose majors that are not in accordance with their majors in secondary education. This means that universities must also be able to adapt in implementing a new student admission system.

In addition, there are several new policies in new student admissions made by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology. Some of the new rules set by the ministry are 1) the implementation of independent pathways by universities which are carried out at the maximum in July, 2) notification to the public about the procedures for admitting new students and their assessment before the implementation of new student admissions, 3) notification to the public about the number of selection participants and the remaining quota and refutation of selection results. In addition, changes in global demands in terms of the quality of human resources require universities to carry out the selection process for new student admissions competitively and with quality screening.

Universitas Negeri Surabaya organizes new student admissions through 3 main channels, namely non-test channels, achievement channels, and computer-based unesa entrance tests (TMUBK). Universitas Negeri Surabaya is committed to continuously improving the quality of new student admissions by adjusting to government policies. Based on this commitment, it is necessary to issue a Guidebook for the Implementation of New Student Admission for Independent Pathways at Surabaya State University.

### B. Objective

This guidebook aims to provide guidance in accepting new students in accordance with established standard provisions and procedures. This guideline is also intended to ensure that the selection process for new student

admissions can filter out qualified prospective students who can be competitive.

**C. Basis of Preparation**

The basis for preparing guidelines for implementing online learning is:

1. Law no. 20 of 2003 concerning the National Education System,
2. Law no. 12 of 2012 concerning Higher Education.
3. Minister of Education and Culture Regulation no. 3 of 2020 concerning National Higher Education Standards
4. Ministry of Education and Culture No. 5 of 2020 concerning Freedom of Learning-Independent Campus
5. Minister of Education and Culture Regulation no. 7 of 2020 concerning the Establishment, Changes, Dissolution of State Universities, and the Establishment, Changes, and Revocation of Private Higher Education Licenses
6. Regulation of the Minister of Education, Culture, Research and Technology of the Republic of Indonesia Number 48 of 2022 concerning Admission of New Students for Diploma and Undergraduate Programs at State Universities

## CHAPTER II

### TYPES OF PATHWAYS, REQUIREMENTS, AND REGISTRATION PROCESS

#### A. NATIONAL New Student Admission Selection Pathway

In general, the new independent student admission pathway consists of 2 pathways, namely Achievement path and Test path.

##### 1. Achievement-Based National Selection Path (SNBP)

National selection based on achievement includes academic and/or non-academic achievements. National selection based on is carried out based on 2 (two) components, namely:

- a. the first component, which is calculated based on the average report card score of all subjects of at least 50% (fifty percent) of the assessment weight; and
- b. the second component, which is calculated based on the report card scores of at most 2 (two) subjects supporting the intended Study Program, portfolio, and/or achievements of at most 50% (fifty percent) of the assessment weight.

##### 2. Test-Based National Selection Path (SNBT)

National selection based on tests is carried out using computer-based standardized tests. Standardized tests are tests that measure cognitive potential, mathematical reasoning, literacy in Indonesian, and literacy in English.

#### B. NEW STUDENT ADMISSION REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

##### 1. Achievement-Based National Selection Pathway (SNBP)

The requirements for participants to take part in SNBP are high school / MA / SMK students in the last class (grade 12) in 2023 who have superior achievements:

- a. having academic achievement and meet the requirements determined by each state university;
- b. having NISN and registered in PDSS;
- c. having report cards from semester 1 to 5 that have been filled in PDSS;
- d. participants who choose arts and sports study programs are required to upload a Portfolio.

The requirements for schools participating in SNBP are as follows.

- a. SMA/MA/SMK that has NPSN.
- b. Accreditation requirements:
  - a. A accreditation: 40% of the best in their school;
  - b. B accreditation: 25% of the best in their school;
  - c. C accreditation and others: 5% of the best in their school.
- d. Filling in the School and Student Database (PDSS). The student data that is filled in is only eligible in accordance with the provisions.



## 2. National Test-Based Selection Pathway (SNBT)

The requirements for participants to join SNBT Year 2023 are as follows.

- a. Having an SNPMB account.
- b. Indonesian citizen (WNI) who has a Population Identification Number (NIK).
- c. SMA/MA/SMK/equivalent students who are prospective graduates in 2023 must have a Certificate of SMA/MA/SMK Class 12 Students or Package C students in 2023 with a maximum age of 25 years (as of July 1, 2023).
- d. Students graduating from SMA/MA/SMK/equivalent in 2021 and 2022 or graduates of Package C in 2021 and 2022 must have a certificate with a maximum age of 25 years (as of July 1, 2023). Graduates of high school equivalent from abroad must have a diploma that has been equalized.
- e. Not passing the SNBP 2023 or SNMPTN pathway in 2021 or 2022.
- f. Having adequate health so as not to interfere with the smooth running of the study process.
- g. Participants who choose the Arts and Sports study program are required to upload a portfolio.
- h. Visually impaired participants are required to upload a Statement of Visibility.
- i. UTBK-SNBT 2023 results are only valid for participating in SNBT and PTN admission 2023.

## CHAPTER III

### DETERMINATION OF CEILING AND CEILING FOR EACH STUDY PROGRAM

#### A. Determination of ceiling

In determining the ceiling of new students to be accepted in each study program, the Sub Directorate of Student Acceptance and Graduation determines the ceiling of students in each study program by considering the number of lecturers in each study program, as well as facilities and infrastructure, especially facilities related to learning in each study program. The development of learning implementation that is not only carried out offline, but can also be carried out online, so the calculation of facilities and infrastructure needs no longer considers facilities and infrastructure for theoretical concept lectures, but facilities and infrastructure that are more considered are facilities and infrastructure for practice-based learning.

After the analysis is carried out, the Sub Directorate of Student Admission and Graduation then reports the results of the analysis to the Academic Director and Vice Rector 1 for Academic and Student Affairs. The results of the report are then followed up by inviting all faculty leaders to determine the ceiling together. In 2023, the overall ceiling details are SNBP = 22%, SNBT = 45%, and SPMB = 33%.

## CHAPTER IV

### REGISTRATION PROCEDURE AND FINANCING

#### A. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

##### 1. SNBP Pathway

- a. Logging in to <https://portal-snpmb.bppp.kemdikbud.go.id> using your student account and select the SNBP registration menu to register, or directly access the page <https://snbp-snpmb.bppp.kemdikbud.go.id>.
- b. If eligible to register, students can proceed with registration.
- c. Filling in the choice of PTN, choice of study program, and additional achievement documents (if any).
- d. Uploading portfolio documents for students who register for arts and sports study programs at the same time as filling in their biodata, choice of PTN, and choice of study program by using the portfolio document template in accordance with the field of choice.
- e. Finalizing and approving the SNBP 2023 disclaimer.
- f. Printing the Participant Identity Card as proof of SNBP participant

##### 2. SNBT Pathway

Prospective participants read complete information about UTBK-SNBT 2023 which can be accessed on the page <https://snpmb.bppp.kemdikbud.go.id>. The next steps taken by prospective participants are:

- a. logging in using an SNPMB account on the page <https://portalsnpmb.bppp.kemdikbud.go.id>;
- b. selecting the UTBK-SNBT menu;
- c. completing the biodata and confirming the end of filling in the biodata if the data has been filled in correctly and completely;
- d. choosing a study program;
- e. uploading portfolios can be taken from SNMPTN 2023 or uploading new ones;
- f. selecting UTBK Center and make final confirmation of UTBK registration;
- g. making UTBK registration payments at partner banks;
- h. confirming the Participant Card while saving permanently.

#### B. REGISTRATION FEE

The cost of administering the SNBP in 2023 is subsidized by the Government through APBN funds allocated to the 2023 Educational Testing Management Center Budget. The cost of organizing SNBT is borne by participants and for KIP-College applicants who are classified as beneficiaries are subsidized through the Educational Testing Management Center budget. This is stated in the Minister of Finance Regulation Number 4 / PMK.02 / 2023 concerning Types and

Rates for Types of Non-Tax State Revenue for Urgent Needs for the National Selection Service for New Student Admissions to State Universities Applicable to the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology. The PMK stipulates that the UTBK-SNBT registration fee rate is IDR 200,000 (two hundred thousand rupiah). The amount of registration fee borne by the participant is Acceptance of SNBT registration fees in 2023 becomes an allocation of Non-Tax State Revenue (PNBP) recorded by the Education Testing Management Center work unit.

## CHAPTER V

### GRADUATION PROCESS

#### A. SNBP Pathway

1. Graduation components and data sources
  - a. Average report card score from SIDATA SNPMB (National Committee)
  - b. Special subject scores from SIDATA SNPMB (National Committee)
  - c. School Accreditation from SIDATA SNPMB (National Committee)
  - d. School Index from SIDATA SNPMB (National Committee)
  - e. Sports and arts voter portfolio scores from SNPMB SIPORTO (National Committee). Instruments, Applications, Assessors are managed by the central committee
  - f. Student achievements (certificates), central committee data, applications and assessors from Unesa. Unesa developed the SIPOLO application to assess achievements/certificates uploaded by SNBP registrants. The assessment is carried out by the Head of Study Program. The SIPOLO component has the following criteria:
    - 1) Certificate level: a) International, b) National, c) Local
    - 2) Certificate status: a) Champion, b) Participant
    - 3) Certificate suitability: a) In accordance with the study program, b) Not in accordance with the study program
2. Final Grade Formula

Sports and Arts Study Program:  $NA = 0.5 \cdot X1 + 0.5 \cdot X5 (0.1 \cdot X6 + 0.2 \cdot X2 + 0.2 \cdot X3 + 0.5 \cdot X4)$

General Study Program:  $NA = 0.5 \cdot X1 + 0.5 \cdot X5 (0.1 \cdot X6 + 0.5 \cdot X2 + 0.4 \cdot X2)$

Description

X1 = Average Report Card Score

X2 = Special Subject Score

X3 = Certificate of Achievement

X4 = Portfolio Value

X5 = School index

X6 = School Accreditation Score
3. Graduation Determination

The pattern set by the central committee in determining graduation is:

  - a. Stage 1. The central committee sends all the data of the 1st choice participants.
  - b. Unesa processes NA for 1st choice participants
  - c. Sort the value from largest to smallest
  - d. Passing the 1st choice participants from the order of the best score up to the number of quotas for the study program.

- e. The first-choice quota is 75% of the SNBP pathway quota. 25% is for the second choice
- f. Unesa uploads participants who pass the first choice to SIDATA SNBP
- g. Stage 2. The central committee sends second choice data, after deducting participants who pass the first choice.
- h. Unesa processes the score like the first stage
- i. Passing the second-choice participants
- j. Unesa uploads participants who pass the second choice to SIDATA SNBP.
- k. At the National Meeting, the Rector determines the first choice and second choice participants.

## **B. SNBT Pathway**

1. Graduation components and data sources
  - a. Portfolio scores for sports and arts electors from SIPORTO SNPMB (National Committee). Instruments, Applications, Assessors are managed by the central committee.
  - b. UTBK scores are managed by the central committee
2. Final Score Formula
 

The final score formula is managed by the central committee
3. Graduation determination
  - a. Determination of graduation is determined by the central committee
  - b. At the National Meeting, the Rector determines the participants who pass the 1st choice and 2nd choice

## CHAPTER VI

### UKT AND UKT DETERMINATION

#### A. SINGLE TUITION FEE (UKT) AND INSTITUTIONAL EDUCATION CONTRIBUTION (SPI) FOR EACH STUDY PROGRAM

Single Tuition Fees (UKT) and Institutional Education Contributions (SPI) for each study program are determined through the Rector's Decree on the determination of UKT and SPI. The UKT and SPI for each study program are as in the attachment to the guidelines.

#### B. CALCULATION AND DETERMINATION OF STUDENT CANDIDATE'S SINGLE TUITION FEE (UKT)

In order for the determination of UKT participants to be perceived fairly, the UKT determination process is carried out by taking into account the economic capabilities of prospective students.

The calculation of UKT is determined at least by calculating the salary of prospective students' parents, vehicles owned, and electricity payments. For prospective students who come from the SNBP and SNBT national pathways, the UKT for prospective students starts from UKT 1 to UKT 8.

**C. CALCULATION AND DETERMINATION OF STUDENT CANDIDATE'S SINGLE TUITION FEE (UKT)**

Participants who pass the SNBP and SNBT pathways with the KIPK pathway, are selected by the field of student affairs based on the KIPK quota received by Unesa.

## **CHAPTER VII**

### **CLOSING**

The quality of higher education starts with student input. The better the input received, the easier and better the quality improvement. One of the initial student input processes is through new student admissions. Good admission of new students will facilitate the next quality improvement process. Therefore, new student admissions must be carried out fairly and wisely in accordance with their designation. One of the new student admission pathways at Surabaya State University is National which includes the SNBP and SNBT pathways.
