

A brief history

The establishment of the Undergraduate Programme in Accounting (UPA) represents a strategic initiative by Universitas Negeri Surabaya (Unesa) to address the evolving needs of the accounting profession within the business and industrial sectors. The programme is designed to produce graduates who exhibit competence, ethics, integrity, and adaptability to advancements in information technology.

The design of the courses, teaching materials, and curriculum structure is intended to align with the dynamic regulatory and policy changes in higher education as mandated by the government, including the graduate competencies outlined in the Indonesian National Qualification Framework (KKNI) and National Higher Education Standards.

Additionally, it reflects a reorientation of the curriculum to meet the challenges posed by the Industrial Revolution 4.0, Society 5.0, and the adoption of the Emancipatory Learning (MBKM) policy programme. It adheres to the International Education Standards (IES) for Professional Accountants established by the International Accounting Education Standards Board (IAESB) to further enrich the curriculum, equipping prospective graduates for the global marketplace. Furthermore, all courses within this programme are conducted in English, providing students valuable international exposure throughout their four-year academic journey.




