This study aimed to look at the company's corporate social responsibility effect to enhance community development from the social, economic, ethical, environmental, and philanthropic perspectives. A total of 401 local communities living nearby industry were selected proportionally from the SNNPR region and Hawassa city from Sidama Region. Quantitative data was collected from local communities using the Paper Assisted Personal Interview (PAPI) technique. Interviews with government officials and focus group discussions with local community members were also undertaken. Analyses were conducted both qualitatively and quantitatively. The quantitative data were analyzed using descriptive statistics and Structural Equation Model to measure the effect of industry activity on community development. Thematic analysis and interpretation were used to examine and understand qualitative data. The study found that companies positively and significantly contribute to enhancing community development regarding social, economic, ethical, philanthropic, and environmental aspects with some limitations. We recommend that companies fulfill their responsibilities to improve community development in a different area, on the one hand, gain community acceptance, and be more profitable on the other. The government also has to control the industries' activities to protect the community from the ill actions of the industries.
